VENDOR CONTRACT

The Stanwood Camano Community Fair (The Fair) Hereby grants exhibitor space on the Stanwood Camano Community Fairgrounds during the 2019 fair to _____ during the dates of August 2, 3, 4, 2019. The vendor agrees to pay The Fair, a booth fee for the three day event. The booth fees, application & contract as well as Certificate of Liability Insurance are due by June 1, 2019. The vendor shall sell only those items listed and approved on the submitted application.

Application, Contract, and Booth Spaces

- All booth spaces will be filled on a first come first serve basis. We do our best to fulfill booth requests but based on our set-up plan it may not be possible. The ultimate decision remains that of The Fair Manager.
- All product and display items must be contained within your booth and not overflowing into walkways or fire lanes. Your items will be removed without notice if rules are not adhered to.
- All vendors must have a Certificate of Liability Insurance naming the Stanwood Camano Community Fair as the additionally insured. Due no later than June 1, 2019.
- This Application & Contract allows the vendor to utilize the designated booth space during the Fair. This space can not be sublet or transferred to any other person, firm, organization, or entity. Vendor shall be responsible for payment of all Local, State, and Federal Taxes.
- Vendor agrees to all policies outlined in the 2019 Stanwood Camano Community Fair Policy Booklet.
- We reserve the right to make changes to the enclosed schematic (map) as needed and without notice.
- **Cancellations made after June 1, 2019 will not be refunded.**

Food Vendors

- The Fair requires each food booth to use a cash register to record all sales. A copy of your register tape must be submitted to the office with your daily concession report.

Set-up & Take Down

- It is suggested that food vendor setup on Wed, July 31 2019 in order to be up and running by Thur, August 1, 2019 at 5pm.
- Absolutely no cars will be allowed on the fairgrounds after 8:30 am each morning. Also, no cars will be allowed on the Fairgrounds prior to the end of the last show each evening. Please refer to the Entertainment schedule for these times.
- **Take Down on Sunday, August 4, 2019 may not take place until after 6:30pm. Cars will not be allowed on the fairgrounds until this time for the safety of our fair patrons**

Business Hours

- **Food booths must be open at all times during normal fair hours: Thur: 5pm- 9pm, Fri-Sat: 9am – 9pm, Sun: 9am - 6pm.**

Parking & Camping

- **Vendors may purchase 3-Day parking passes at a cost of \$25.00 each . This cost is billed with your booth and passes will not be available at a later date.**
- Also available, free parking & shuttle service at Stanwood High School. The service runs every 15 mi during fair hours
- If you wish to camp during the fair you must reserve your space in advance. When making your reservations, indicate the size and type of unit (motor home, trailer, tent, etc...)
- Camping is via a dry site only, no sewer or water hook-up.
- **Under no circumstances will vendors be allowed to camp in their booth on the fairgrounds.**
- There is no power available for camping

Booth space and placement is on a first come first serve basis. No space will be assigned until the Fair Manager receives all properties of the agreement/contract.
